The Weimar Bee Symposium is the annual conference of the Prof. Ludwig Armbruster Beekeeping School. We expect around 350 participants on Friday and Saturday this year, the event will be made available to the public in a multilingual live stream.

This year's Weimar Bee Symposium is under the patronage of Apimondia. President Jeff Pettis, Vice President Peter Kozmus and General Secretary Riccardo Jannoni-Sebastianini are looking forward to the specialist event in Weimar and contribute to the international character of the event through their speeches.

The motto of the event is „Biodiversity, the death of insects and the future of beekeeping under the auspices of climate change“.

In a further thematic focus we turn to the problems of insect mortality and the necessary transformation process in agriculture.

The exhibition takes place on Friday and Saturday in the „Schiesshaus zu Weimar“ (www.schiesshaus-weimar.de). A maximum of 35 exhibitors can use their communication point there. The participants visit the stands during the breaks, so you as an exhibitor also have the opportunity to attend the lectures. We expect around 350 people, 100 of them multipliers from several European countries. Your presence at the event serves primarily to build networks and initiate new business relationships.
